SKEMA SCHOLARSHIPS

BBA in Global Management merit award INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Type of grant: Study

Amount: €2,000 deductible from the tuition fee

Duration: 1 year

Criteria: Academic results, letter of motivation, English test

Grant funded by: SKEMA Business School

Applying: Admitted international students must send their scholarship request by e-mail to international.admissions@skema.edu

BBA Sport Excellence award FRENCH AND INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Students on the BBA programmes who have been granted the status of 'Athlete Students' can receive a Sports Scholarship of up to €2,000 per year.

Grant funded by: SKEMA Business School.

Application: On the online application, tick the box entitled 'High Level Athlete Status Scholarship.'

Master in Management, Grande Ecole programme awards INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Type of grant: Study

Amount: €3,000 deductible from the tuition fees

Duration: 1 year

Criteria: Academic results, letter of motivation, English test

Grant funded by: SKEMA Business School

Masters of science excellence scholarship INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

SKEMA Business School offers this scholarship to attract bright and talented students and help them to realise their full potential and achieve their personal and professional goals.

Eligibility: all admitted international students can apply

Application deadline: within two weeks of admission.

Selection criteria: the Scholarships Jury's decision will be based on the following criteria:

- academic excellence (GPA)
 - the overall strength of the application
 - the results of the selection interview
- GMAT, or GRE, or TAGE MAGE will be an asset

Amount of the Excellence scholarship: up to €4,000

This scholarship is deducted from the tuition fees.

In the case of a Two-Year MSc programme, please note that the scholarship is awarded for the first year only.

Application: admitted international students must send their scholarship request by e-mail to international.admissions@skema.edu

BBA and Masters of science Early Enrolment scholarship INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Eligibility: all admitted international students can apply

Selection criteria: the Scholarships Jury's decision will be based on the following criteria:

- academic excellence (GPA)
- motivation

Amount of the "Early enrolment" scholarship: €1,000 (for outstanding students who confirm their registration before 31 October for the next January intake; or before 31 March for the next September intake).

This scholarship is deducted from the tuition fees.

In the case of a Two-Year MSc programme, please note that the scholarship is awarded for the first year only.

Please note that the Early Enrolment scholarship cannot be combined with another scholarship awarded by SKEMA Business School.

MSc Digital Business scholarship

At least one international MSc Digital Business student is to be awarded a €5,400 scholarship for each autumn intake. The scholarship comes from the University of Côte d'Azur's Academy of Excellence on Networks, Information and Digital Society. Every non-French applicant is eligible for the scholarship and will automatically be considered for the scholarship once registered on the programme.

Eligibility criteria:

1. Non-French national / non-French resident
2. Academic excellence
3. End-of-studies internship on the Cote d'Azur

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS AWARDED BY THE FRENCH GOVERNMENT

Need-based grants from the French Ministry of Higher Education and Research

BACHELOR AND MASTERS FRENCH AND INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Programme description: the need-based grants offered by the French Ministry of Higher Education and Research are intended primarily for French students, but some classes of foreigners may also be eligible:

- Students who are nationals of a member country of the European Union or the European Economic Space and who previously held a permanent job in France (full or part time) or whose parents or legal guardian earned income in France. This restriction does not apply if the student can demonstrate a sufficient degree of integration into French society (as measured, for example, by length of stay, time spent in French schools, or family ties in France. The latter condition is not required if the student can prove that he or she has lived continuously in France for 5 years.
- International students living in France for at least 2 years and whose home for tax purposes (for dependent students, the home of the student's mother, father, or legal guardian) has been France for at least 2 years.
- Andorran students who attended French schools may also apply.
- Students who are refugees or stateless persons as demonstrated by a refugee card or residency permit showing refugee status
- Additional assistance may be available to recipients of need-based grants:

Merit aid may be provided to grantees who are enrolled in an institution or programme authorized to accept scholarship students and who graduated with honors from secondary school (as indicated by a grade of "très bien" on their baccalaureate or equivalent (eg. IB diploma, high school diploma).

Only SKEMA's Master in Management, Grande École programme is authorised to grant CROUS scholarships. With institutional recommendation, merit aid may also be given to students in master's programs who completed their 'licence' with honours

International mobility (travel) grants are available for students who choose to study or complete an internship abroad as part of their post-secondary programme.

Under some circumstances, arrangements can be made to have grant payments continue during the long summer vacation

Type of grant: Study

Value/Benefits: Aid is granted as a function of three criteria:

- The income of the student's household
- The number of children in the household, and the number enrolled in higher education
- The distance between the student's home and educational institution
- Grant amounts vary depending on these criteria. An aid calculator is available on the CNOUS Web site.
- Grantees are exempted from tuition and fees and are not required to pay for their membership in the national student health insurance scheme.

Duration: Grants are made for the academic year (October through June)

Number of grants: Approximately 500,000 grants are made each year to French and non-French students.

Grant funded by: French government

Application: Prospective applicants should contact the regional student-service agency (CROUS) serving the institution in which they are enrolled. Contact information for the regional agencies can be found on the website of the national student-service agency (CNOUS) - www.etudiant.gouv.fr

Eiffel master's grants from the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs

MASTERS INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Programme description: the programme of Eiffel excellence grants, launched in January 1999 by the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs, is designed to support the international student recruitment efforts of French Institutions of Higher Education. The objectives of this grant programme are to train, in France's post-secondary institutions, future world leaders in three priority areas (science, economics and management, and law and political science) and to encourage applications from students from emerging countries in Asia, Latin America, Eastern Europe, the Middle East, and the new member states of the European Union.

The applications will be submitted by SKEMA Business School to Campus France, the programme administrator. Direct applications from students cannot be accepted.

Value/Benefits: In addition to the monthly stipend, grantees receive the following additional benefits: travel, health insurance, and a cultural programme. Grantees may also be eligible for housing assistance and a programme of language training preceding their master's programme.

Duration: Eiffel master's grants are awarded for one or two years.

Number of grants: Approximately 400 grants are offered each year.
