The application form must include:

- A Statement of Purpose (maximum 1500 words) that demonstrates your potential for excellent doctoral work and a successful career as an academic researcher. Your Statement of Purpose should address the following key points: (1) Explain why you are interested in pursuing a PhD in management, and specifically why you are applying to SKEMA's program; (2) Provide a brief overview of your academic background, highlighting your research-related qualifications, activities, and achievements that prepare you for doctoral study; (3) Outline your long-term career plans and how completing a PhD will help you achieve these goals; and (4) Describe your intended area of specialization, including your theoretical perspective, proposed research methodology, and a study plan for your doctoral research.
- A detailed curriculum vitae
- Copy of diplomas and grades
- A photocopy of the official results of the TOEFL (Test of English as Foreign Language), TOEIC, or of the

Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE) for applicants whose native language is not English (unless the Master was delivered in English)

- Two (or more) letters of recommendation
- One photo
- If available: a research work relevant to the candidate's evaluation (e.g., working paper, article, or thesis) and a list of these documents (see below)
- The name of the university and the (expected) degree conferral date
- If available, results of: GMAT (Graduate Management Admission Test); GRE (Graduate Record Examinations); TOEFL (Test of English as Foreign Language), TOEIC, or of the Certificate of Proficiency in English (CPE).
- The candidate's citizenship
